Dear Mr. Elliott,

This letter serves a two-fold purpose; operational information and as your OSRO letter for 2021 (Reporting Year 2020). Your facility previously engaged Weavertown Environmental Group (WEG) as a recognized Coast Guard OSRO under OSRO #075. WEG has been acquired by EnviroServe, a Savage Company. EnviroServe is an established OSRO also, operating under OSRO #476. As EnviroServe, the Carnegie location that you are familiar with will remain in place, with the same contact information, personnel and equipment, but with access to additional trained personnel and equipment in the event of an incident.

The WEG Carnegie location joins with the EnviroServe Cuddy, PA operation, to form the Pittsburgh Operations, based at the existing Carnegie location. As part of EnviroServe, the Pittsburgh Operations has access to available resources throughout the tri-state area. In addition to the Emergency Response telephone number currently in your Facility Response Plan (800-746-4850), you may include the EnviroServe emergency phone number, 800-488-0910.

This letter will also serve as your OSRO letter for the calendar year 2021. The Carnegie location has complied with the Oil Pollution Act of 1990 (OPA-90) and 33 CFR Parts 154.1055(f) and 154.1045 concerning equipment inspections, deployments, and maintenance. In addition, the required drills, exercises and notifications have been completed over the past twelve months. EnviroServe personnel are OSHA HAZWOPER trained in compliance with 29 CFR 1910.120 and specifically trained to respond to an oil release as specified in 33 CFR 154.105 and 40 CFR 194.

Response equipment has been deployed on numerous occasions throughout the year, which has exceeded the minimum NPREP required amount for each type. This has been accomplished by

conducting training exercises and through actual spill response. This response equipment includes boats, containment boom, skimmers, pumps and vacuum trucks.

Response equipment has been properly maintained through inspections prior to deployment, and response personnel have received the appropriate training requirements to handle this equipment. Personnel records are retained for three years in compliance with OSRO NPREP Guidelines.

EnviroServe has received official classification as an approved OSRO from the U.S. Coast Guard National Strike Force. Classification information can be accessed at the Coast Guard's website online at <https://cgrri.uscg.mil/userreports/webclassificationreport.aspx>.
